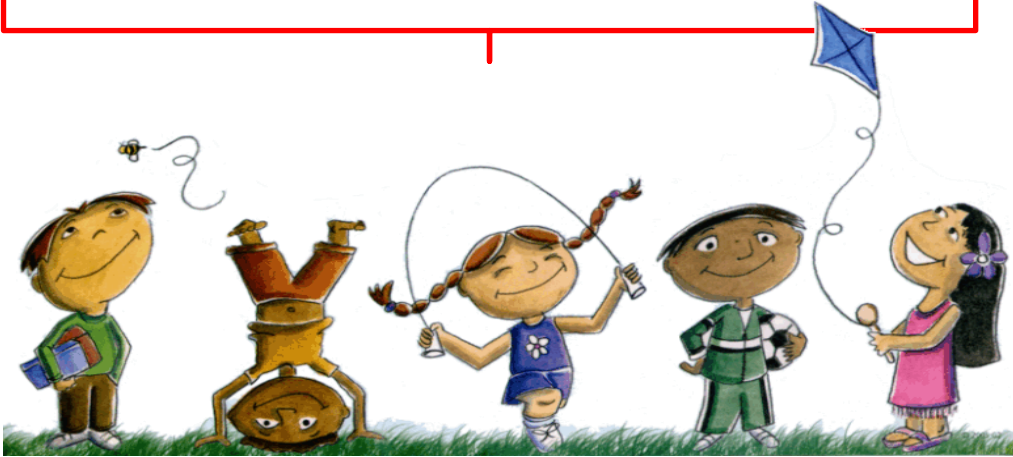


FREE DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENINGS

FOR CHILDREN AGES BIRTH THROUGH 5



Screenings can help determine if your child is on track with developmental milestones. Areas screened include:

- **Speech/language**
- **Cognitive** (understanding of basic concepts & remembering)
- **Motor skills**
- **Hearing and vision**

COVID-19 Precautions:

- *Masks required for ages 5+
- *Only 1 adult per child and only children to be screened will be admitted
- *Walk-ins will be limited and may have to wait to allow for social distancing
- *Temperatures will be checked prior to entry and sanitizer provided
- *Anyone with symptoms will be asked to reschedule
